This quotation shows that the main female character no one supports her to write because he still hasn't recovered from her depression.

b. Struggle fact of life

The second type of gender struggle experienced by the main female's character is the struggle for the facts of life. The struggle about the facts of life is not only related to the meaning of human life and the necessities of life. More than that is the struggle to be able to realize the desire for other things above their general needs. These desires are clearly not as easy as the general needs to be achieved, but through various kinds of struggle and recognition(Eka Wahyu Nusantara et al., 2022). In the process of analyzing, the writer analyzes this struggle on when she feel lonely and and her husband does not let her do the things she likes for fear he's afraid she'll do the things she doesn't want but he doesn't even know if she feels lonely:

"John is away all day, and even some nights when his cases are serious. I am glad my case is not serious! But these nervous troubles are dreadfully depressing. John does not know how much I really suffer. He knows there is no REASON to suffer, and that satisfies him."

(Gilman, 1892:4)

This quotation shows that the main female character thinks that her husband thinks she is weak and can not do anything because she is sick.

c. Struggle of affection

The third form of gender struggle experienced by the female character is the struggle for attention. The struggle of women in achieving affection is not easy if examined. This is because it is inversely proportional to what women try to get from affection. If a woman is only looking for love, then it can be with kindness and treatment of affection, but the problem can lie with other people whether the person wants something other than love (Ratna Sari & Fitria, 2017). In the process of analyzing, the writer analyzes this struggle when she attraching her husband's attention by always paying attention to her.

"I don't weigh a bit more," said I, "nor as much; and my appetite may be better in the evening when you are here, but it is worse in the morning when you are away!"

(Gilman, 1892:9)

This quotation shows that the main female character wants her husband to always be by her side

Love itself in scientific and realistic studies is still an abstract and elusive thing. It is discovered that the primary female character, a wife and mother who loses her child in the struggle for dreams, fact of life, affection, and love has a gender struggle. In this instance, various other characters, including the primary female character's husband, can also be shown to struggle with gender. Although her husband appears to be holding her, in reality he is also working to help her recover and doesn't always consider their deceased kid.

CONCLUSION

Employing feminism theory, which focuses on gender struggles, to analyze the gender struggle displayed by the main female character in the short story "The Yellow Wallpaper." The main female character is a mother who lost her child and is depressed so that her husband is forced to lock her up and that is where the main character experiences a gender struggle because she feels imprisoned by her husband and does not feel freedom. After analyzing the gender struggle shown by main female character in The Yellow Wallpaper short story by Charlotte Perkins Gilman use Paddy MacQueen's theory, this study comes to the conclusion that the primary female character's gender struggle involves a dream, fact of life, affection, and love.
